## **Frequently Asked Questions:**

### **Q. What is this event?**

A. The MHA Auction is an important fundraiser for the school, year after year. All proceeds go to assist children and families in need of the scholarship fund. Due to COVID, this year’s event is going to look a bit different than in past years. But don’t worry- it will still be fun!

This year’s “A Night At The Safari” Auction event will take place on March 7, and is the closing event for the Auction. We hope that you will participate and join us in this excitement!

The evening festivities will occur as a scavenger hunt. Once you purchase tickets, you will receive an email with detailed information on how to begin. There will be 4 stops- each with its own gift and mini adventure- with the last stop including your To-go dinner box.

### **Q. Is this a COVID-safe event?**

A. Yes! We are so excited to be able to have an event to support our school, while also being COVID-safe. In order to ensure the safety of all participants, we are staggering the start times so there are not crowds forming at each location. Once you purchase a ticket, you will receive a ‘sign-up genius’ by email to pick a time slot.

As well, all food will be assembled and prepared at the MHA, with precautions in place.

Please be mindful of others while attending this event. If you are having symptoms of COVID, please do not attend.

### **Q. How long will the event take?**

A. The scavenger hunt time slots begin at 6pm and the entire evening should last approximately 2 hours.

### **Q. Is this a competition? Can we make teams?**

A. While there will be prizes throughout the night, this is not a competition. Enjoy a fun night out with your spouse!

### **Q. What if we can’t figure out one of the 4 clues?**

A. Not to worry! All participants will be given Rabbi Owens’ personal cell phone number and can call him 24/7 with questions. Joking. You will however, receive a phone number at the beginning of the scavenger hunt and if you’re having trouble with a clue...just call!

Q. Can I bring my kids?

A. No...Adults only! (Hurray!)

Q. What kind of prizes/activities can I expect at stops?

A. Let's just say...it's going to be wild! This is "A Night At The Safari" after all...Get ready for some fun COVID safe activities, entertainment and snacks!

Q. When and where can I buy tickets for this event?

Tickets for the event will be on sale until February 28<sup>th</sup>.

Q. Can I pay for one ticket and then bring my husband along but he won't get a meal?

A. Anyone attending the event, whether just for the scavenger hunt or just for the dinner, will need to pay the full price. While we understand and appreciate that there is nothing preventing you from doing the above, we respectfully ask that you understand that this is a school fundraiser and act accordingly.

Q. What if I sponsored the event, but do not plan to attend?
