

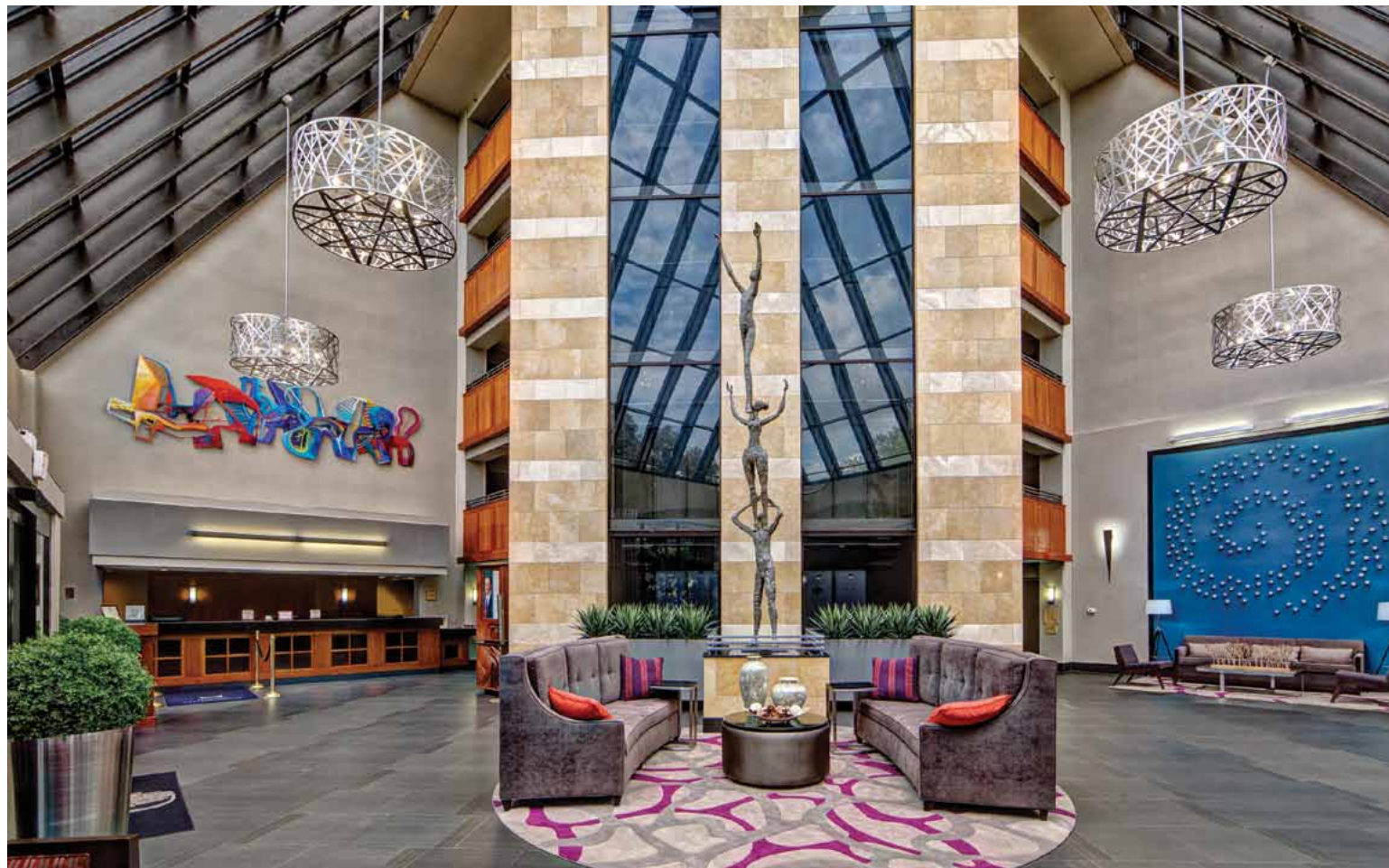

MHA '68

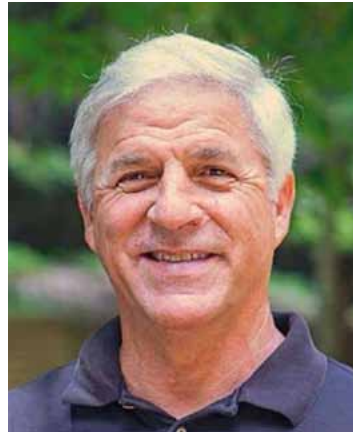

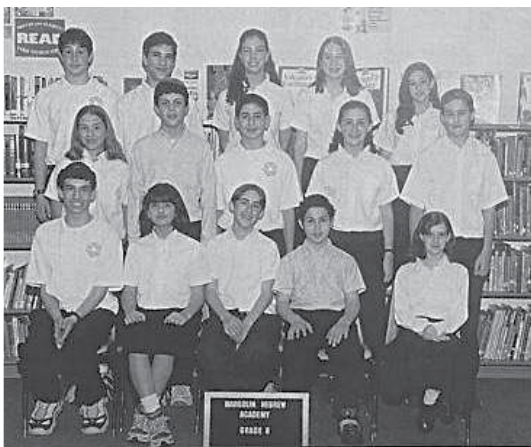
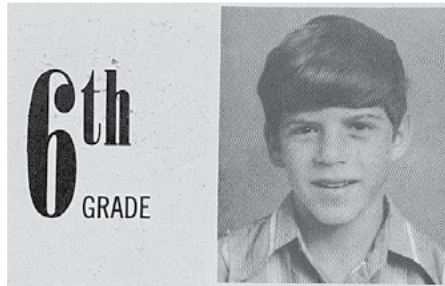
Jamie Gibber

Message from the Head of School

These weeks of *Sefirat HaOmer* - a period of preparation to receive the *Torah* - are days dedicated to personal growth. As such, there is a widely held practice to study *Pirkei Avot*, The Ethics of our Fathers, during this time.

In the beginning of *Pirkei Avot*, the *mishna* teaches us three things that the Men of Great Assembly used to say. The second of these teachings is והעמידו תלמידים הרבה - and establish many students.

The early seventeenth century commentator *Tosafot Yom Tov*, Rabbi Gershon Shaul Yom-Tov Lipmann, notes that the *mishna* does not use the more typical word to describe the relationship between rebbe and student - teach or instruct. Instead, the *mishna* uses the word establish or raise.

The *Tosafot Yom Tov* offers two explanations for the *mishna's* choice of words.

First, the *mishna* intends to convey the desired outcome when working with students. Teachers should not be satisfied with the act of teaching. They must prepare students to stand on their own two feet. Their students must have their own love for learning and their own tools to be an independent learner. The goal of the teacher is the raising of a student who one day can take the teacher's place.

Second, the *mishna* intends to convey that all forms of supporting students are included in raising students. Raising students is not limited to teaching; it includes providing for a student's welfare and helping the student in other ways. The teacher is critically important, but there are many others who play a necessary role in establishing a student.

Taken together, the *Tosafot Yom Tov* describes the critical roles of the teacher and the community in supporting a student to become a link in the transmission of the *Torah*.

This picture that the *Tosafot Yom Tov* paints of what it takes to establish students has particular relevance at an event such as our gala tonight in which we are recognizing our alumni generally and specifically. Our school is so fortunate! We have teachers who are dedicated to developing students and who see their role as extending far beyond the classroom. We also have a community of supporters who ensure that our students have everything they need to be successful - be it financial scholarships, love and attention or *Shabbos* meals. The MHA-FYOS community creates students. We have such a special community, indeed!

I have had the privilege of serving the MHA-FYOS community for seven years. I will miss the community very much and I am very proud of the work that we have done together in establishing the next generation of students. May Hashem continue to bless our community and to establish the work of our hands.

And he shall be like a tree planted by streams of water, that brings forth its fruit in its season, and whose leaf does not wither; and in whatsoever he does, he shall prosper.

Fruit does not grow as soon as a tree is planted, but with the appropriate care and attention, the fruit will appear in time. Similarly our roots at the MHA-FYOS provide for our students to blossom and develop on a foundation of rigorous academics, in both general and Judaic studies, within a Jewish environment and grow up with a love of G-d, the Jewish People, and the State of Israel. It is our hope that these students become alumni who then later return to become roots of the tree for the next generation.

It is so wonderful to have in person events again, however they don't happen without a tremendous amount of work. Thank you to Chana Dina Goldblatt for coordinating this evening along with banquet chairs, Elana Kahane, Cindi Weinstein and Dena Wruble and Journal Chairs, Tracey Mendelson and Shayna Somer as well as everyone who has worked with them. As an active parent and volunteer at the Margolin Hebrew Academy and Baron Hirsch Synagogue, Belle Albert had a vision in 1964. Her vision was for parents to honor their children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren by donating money to put their names in a book once a year. When her oldest daughter started Pre-K at MHA, she realized how important it was to let the “jewels” of Judaism shine brightly for all to see. She advocated that continuation of Jewish life and Jewish tradition starts with the children. She wanted the jewel page to be affordable as to include every single family in the Jewish community. She worked tireless hours calling and collecting money from parents. No one ever said “no” to Belle Albert and this legacy carries on today. Belle always said, “These are my jewels!” Years later her legacy is still honored. Today the page is named after her, The Belle Albert Jewel pages.
